



Supplies

- 1. Bowl
- 2. Swabs
- 3. Gauze dressing

Inner cannulas should be cleaned immediately after each inner cannula change.



Prepare a bowl with tap water (drinkable), or if needed, sterile or distilled water



Rinse your used inner cannula in a bowl of luke warm water.



Clean the inner cannula from both ends with the swab. Use as many swabs as needed for cleaning.



Use a swab to clean the outside of the inner cannula.



Rinse your used inner cannula in a bowl of luke warm water.



Leave to air dry. Place in clean and dry storage container until next use. Discard swab after each use.

Attention

Never insert the swab into the tracheostoma itself to clean. The inner cannula must always be removed from the outer cannula prior to cleaning.
